

- Judges decision shall be final.

- Judges may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

The Standardbred section is a Horse of the Year Qualifier.

PLEASE NOTE: Courtenay A & P is no longer affiliated with the RAS, therefore a win in an Open, Novice or Paced and Mannered Class will not be signed off on Life or Annual Height Certificates.

CLEAN SPORT - our show runs under clean sport rules. Forbidden substance is any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse or pony by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. Your entry into the Show denotes acceptance of these conditions.

ARREARS - No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

CONDUCT - Inappropriate behaviour towards show officials, Judges and fellow competitors, or any other third party connected with the show is unacceptable. Offenders will be removed from the grounds.

- The Committee reserves the right to object to and /or remove from the grounds any person being heavy handed or harsh to a horse or pony.

- The Members in Attendance may remove any horse or pony from the ring, if in their opinion, it is a danger to other competitors.

- **No** prizes to be awarded if the Judge considers the horse unsound. Judges are directed to award prizes only to animals, which they consider free from hereditary unsoundness.

STALLIONS AND COLTS - Please note stallions are permitted in Hunter Jumping. All other classes to be mare or gelding, unless stallion has prior approval by Horse Convener in writing.

- All stallions and colts (with the exception of Miniature horses, foals and Shetland yearlings) must be shown in a bit.

- A Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor.

- It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring.

GENERAL RULES

- Names of horses to be given. In stating age of horse, the year to count from 1st August.
- All riders ages are as at 1st August. Open pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under seventeen years of age.
- In all classes where height is specified an annual or life height certificate are acceptable or a day measure from our show. 5mm will be allowed for shoes.
- Refunds: 75% refund upon production of a medical or veterinary certificate. Substitutions accepted – contact Secretary.
- Courtenay A&P reserves the right to combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
- All Hackneys, Non Hackneys, Pleasure Harness Horse & Pony and Miniature Horses in harness are invited to parade just prior to the Horse Parade.
- Competitors may be disqualified if not ready when called. Consideration cannot be given to riders where judging times in different groups conflict. Entering in different sections is at your own risk.

DEFINITION OF NOVICE

- A Novice exhibit or rider, is one that has yet to win six (6) classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A & P Show/Event. Once you have achieved six wins in Confirmation (and this includes Lady's and Gent's classes) and /or Paced and Mannered classes, you can no longer enter in Novice classes in that category.
- Novice wins to be counted at time of Show.
- If Horse/Pony is upgraded, entry to another class is permitted or entry fee can be reclaimed. Inquiries to the Secretary.
- Novice Horse & Ponies to be shown in **snaffle bits** only.
- Novice may enter open classes.
- As District Classes are restricted, they do not count as an Open or Novice win. A win in a district/novice (no wins) does not count for an Open or Novice Class win
- Adults may ride in Novice Pony Classes on the flat, with the exception of Novice Pony Stallions.
- Novice Pony Stallions must be led or ridden by a rider 14 years and over.
- Open Pony Stallions must be ridden by a rider 14, 15 or 16 years of age, led handlers must be 14 years and over.
- Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be 12 years and over.
- Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older.
- Age of riders is as at 1st August.
- Horse/Pony 3 years of age and under are not permitted in ridden or driven classes.

DISTRICT

- Exhibitor and Rider must reside in the district, between the Rakaia and Waimakariri Rivers, and west of the Main South, Dawsons and Chattertons Roads.

BACK NUMBERS - Courtenay A & P Association Back Numbers OR rider/handler supplied Breastplate Numbers to be worn by riders/handlers.

- Back Numbers or Breastplate Numbers to be worn in the Grand Parade.
- Courtenay A & P Association Back Numbers can be ordered before the show or by paying a refundable cash deposit of \$5.00 for each back number on the day of the show.
- Collection of Courtenay A & P Association Back Numbers occurs on the day of the show.
- Each Back Number not returned will incur a \$10.00 fee. Please return the number to the Secretary's office when you have finished competing for your refund.

THE M E JENKINS MEMORIAL TROPHY is awarded on a four-year rotation to the Supreme Exhibit in a named Horse Section. The trophy will be rotated as follows:

- 2025 - Group A, B, C, & Saddle Hunter Ponies
- 2026 - Hacks, Park Hacks, Saddle Hunters, Riding Horse
- 2027 - Ridden Cobs, Ridden Standardbreds, Ridden Arabians
- 2028 - Led Show Ponies, Led Hacks & Hunters, Led Welsh, Led Shetlands
- 2029 - Group A, B, C, & Saddle Hunter Ponies
